

Shoot starts for Independent's *uwantme2killhim?* with new cast

Jamie Blackley and Toby Regbo now lead the cast of the UK thriller, based on a real-life story.

Shooting started last week in the UK for new thriller [uwantme2killhim?](#), which is being sold by Independent.

Andrew Douglas directs from Mike Walden's script, based on a *Vanity Fair* article about the true story of teenagers who met online with violent results.

Because there was a delay in production, the film has now been recast, with Jamie Blackley (*Snow White & The Huntsman*), Toby Regbo (*One Day*) and Joanne Froggatt (TV's *Downton Abbey*). The cast also features Liz White, Jaime Winstone and Mark Womack. [When a July shoot was announced in Cannes, the cast had included Jack O'Connell and Olly Alexander.]



Shooting will take place mostly on location in Harlow, Essex and Hemel Hempstead, Hertfordshire, also with a week of shooting at Elstree Studios.

As previously reported, [Momentum](#) has UK rights and sister company [Alliance Films](#) has Canadian rights. The Weinstein Company has acquired several major territories.

Prescience's [Aegis Film Fund](#) is financing.

Bryan Singer had optioned the article in 2005 to direct himself, but he will now serve as a producer.
